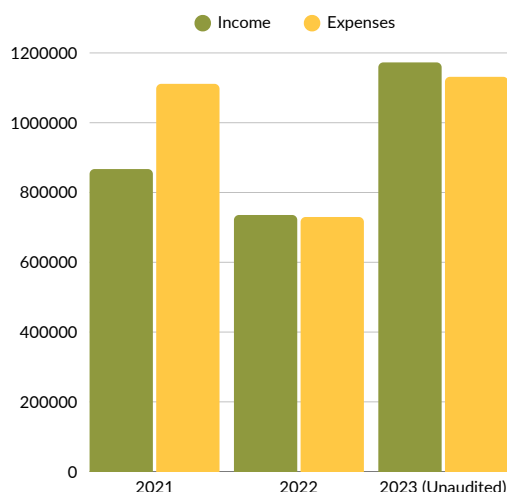

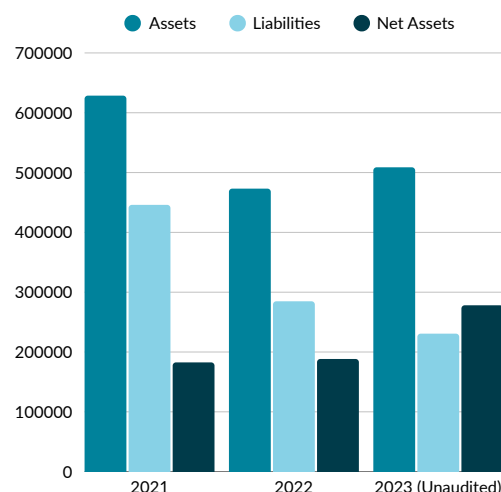
THREE-YEAR FINANCIAL REVIEW

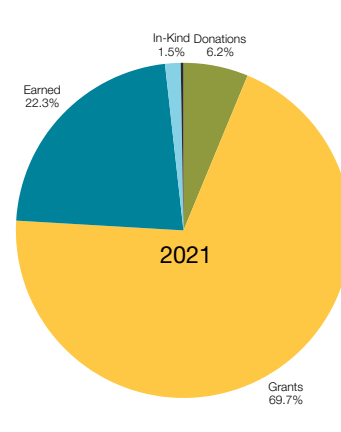
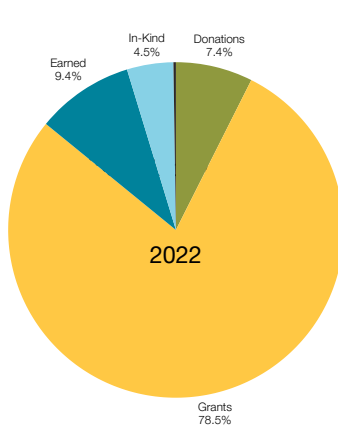
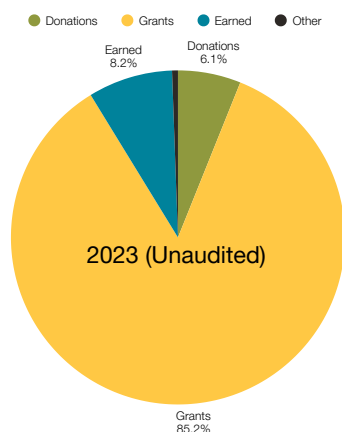
Income vs. Expenses
